Original Maps

The Schneider family's several donations to the Library are enumerated in lists prepared by Richard Schneider, 1999-2004. In 2005, the Rare Book and Manuscript Library (RBML) transferred to the Illinois History and Lincoln Collections (IHLC) 34 "Illinois" maps (both single sheet maps and maps in books). Those transfers are indicated by annotations in Richard Schneider's lists, located in the Schneider Collection's work file. The collection contains eight world maps, 1750-1800, and 36 Illinois maps, 1763-1929. For a list of the maps, see the work files.

Schneider obtained copies of several original maps from the Library of Congress. The copies are bound in a single folio volume which was donated to the Library by Lorraine Schneider in 2000. Richard Schneider listed these maps, and other copied maps, in 2000, and his list, as annotated, serves as a guide to

IHLC's holdings. There are both positive and negative copies of the majority of these maps, but only one copy of some of them.
