- > Applicants must secure adequate funding to support participation in the program.
- > Program is delivered in English only, and participants should be fluent in conversational English and possess a reading knowledge of English.



COST

The 2025 program cost is \$4,000 USD. It covers program fees, housing, some meals, local transportation and medical insurance. It does not cover expenses for visa application, and airfare and/or ground transportation to and from Champaign-Urbana.
