

Current Endowed Support

The **Mary Kathryn Bieniecki Memorial Endowment Fund** was established by Henry Bieniecki in memory of his wife. It provides support to the School Collection of literature for children and young adults.

The **Fessler Family University Library Endowment** was established to support acquisition of material related to coaching, training, sport history, sport psychology, the impact of sport on cultures, the science of sport, as well as topics related to specific sports.

The James E. and Sue E. Freytag Library Endowment Fund was established to support acquisition and preservation of all formats of material appropriate for maintaining and improving the collections, programs, and services of the Education and Social Science Library.

The **Lambda Literature Endowment Fund** was established by Roger Clark, an alumnus, to acquire materials for the gay literature collection at the Library.

The **Shirley and John Mahaffey Library Endowment Fund** was established to support the former Education and Social Science Library, now SSHEL.
